Who?

Jamie's Preschool is for immune-compromised children aged 3–6 from oncology/hematology, and their siblings

Jamie's has strict health policies to support the well-being of our children. We have neutropenic kids attending who must be protected! All attendees, in class and on field trips, must be free of cold and flu symptoms, and taking reasonable precautions against exposure to common infections. Families are expected to report any possible exposures to serious contagious diseases. Children must have had chicken pox or the varicella vaccine if they are not being isolated from unknown community contacts.

Where?

Jamie's Preschool is located at St. Andrew's United Church, 924 Heritage Drive SW

Our gym program is held at the Calgary STARS Gymnastics and Cheerleading Centre.

When?

Regular classes are held Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons

Hours vary depending on scheduling of gymnastics. Some field trips are scheduled outside of class time.
